About 1/3 of our nation's malls are deteriorating as a result of an over-saturated market. Many developers, mall owners, and municipalities across the United States have already started down the path of retrofitting malls and big box stores into vibrant mixed-use centers, schools, universities, churches, nursing homes, and offices. Professor Dunham-Jones will cover the latest techniques for retrofitting suburbia and illustrate successful case studies from across the nation.

Ellen Dunham-Jones is a professor at Georgia Tech where she coordinates the MS Urban Design degree. An authority on sustainable suburban redevelopment, she is co-author of Retrofitting Suburbia. She serves as chair of the Congress for the New Urbanism and is on the American Institute of Architects Design and Health Leadership Group.

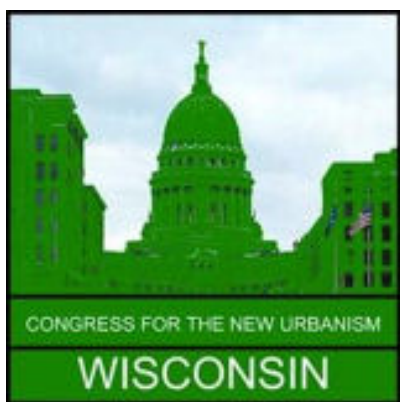
